## Financial Information

Ottawa Dog Rescue's fiscal year end is November 30<sup>th</sup>. The following financials encompass the period running from December 1<sup>st</sup> 2013 to November 30<sup>th</sup> 2014.

## Expenses

Veterinary costs	\$60,737
Admin costs <i>Accounting, website, postage and supplies, banners, transport fees (gas), liability insurance, banking fees, business cards, event fees etc.</i>	\$ 5,574
Miscellaneous costs <i>Adoption costs, shelter pull fees, dog supplies, assessment &amp; behavioural training costs, dog tags etc.</i>	\$ 6,113
Fundraising <i>Included in this amount are Rock and Rescue 2014 proceeds which were equally dispensed among 4 benefiting rescues – ODR, SWM, Valley Animal Rescue and Valley Mastiff Rescue. This also includes merchandise, microchips etc.</i>	\$14,208
